In addition to the substantial savings you get with generic drugs, we included four brand name medications on our co-pay program. Working with pharmaceutical companies, we negotiated great pricing on these drugs and pass the savings on to you. When you use the drugs below, you pay a flat co-pay of \$5 for a 30-day supply and \$7.50 for a 90-day supply of each of the medications.

## Your Safety Is Assured

One reason hospitals stopped offering employees prescription services was safety. Systems and processes didn't exist to protect you.

The new twist assures your safety ... something Atlantic Health System views as paramount to dispensing medications.

When you fill your prescriptions through us, you'll work with exceptional pharmacists who can counsel you on drug interactions, dosages and other factors. Plus, our hospital pharmacists use Express Scripts, a secure network that tracks your medications and looks for drug interactions and safety precautions. The system helps prevent accidentally filling a prescription that may have been filled at a retail drug store. And the system keeps your drug history in one secure database so your pharmacists can best counsel you.

## Getting Medicine Is Easy

Your new prescription plan is convenient. Simply drop off your prescriptions and our pharmacist gets you the medicine you need. Each work location has a prescription drop off center. Once a day, we pick up prescriptions and bring them to Mountainside Pharmacy. Your order is brought back to your location within 24 to 48 hours.

With most prescriptions filled within 2 days, when ordering maintenance medications for problems like high blood pressure you'll get medication faster than ordering through Express Scripts and other mail or Internet ordering services.

All you have to do is come to work and let our pharmacist know what you need. It's that easy. There's no identification cards, no claim forms, no hassles.

That's a great twist on an old idea.

To get started, complete a patient profile with your first order; similar to a profile you would fill out at any drug store, it's available at each hospital in a secure and private drop off/pick up location. ## Save Money ... Substantially

The greatest twist comes in how much money you save. We've negotiated special prices on medications and we're taking advantage of generic drugs to reduce the costs both you and Atlantic Health System pay for medications. By asking for generic drugs, you save money.

Here's a new twist.

With the In-house Prescription Plan, when you use generic equivalents of drugs prescribed on an ongoing basis, you pay a co-pay of \$5 for a 30-day supply and \$7.50 for a 90-day supply. Even better, your first 3 fills on each maintenance drug are completely free when you chose generic equivalents. For people taking many medications, this savings is truly substantial.

*For example, if you have high blood pressure and require a monthly prescription of Lasix, your first 3 month supply of the generic equivalent is free. Starting with the fourth month, you'll pay either \$5 for a 30-day or \$7.50 for a 90-day supply based on your needs. If you choose to use the brand name drug, you would pay approximately \$50 (non-formulary).*

When you use the plan for generic, non-maintenance prescriptions – those used for emergencies, illness and other one time uses – your medication costs \$5 for a 30 day supply. If you want the brand name drug, you'll pay the same cost our existing prescription plan covers for that drug.

*For example, if you have bronchitis and your doctor prescribes Cipro, you can have our pharmacist fill the prescription with the generic equivalent for \$5. Or you can choose to get the brand name and pay \$74.88 (non-formulary).*

Keep two things in mind. First, our couriers travel between drop off locations and our pharmacy twice a day. Based on when you drop off your prescription, it could take 24 to 48 hours to
